To apply for the 2010 – 2011 school year, bring with you:

- Social security numbers for student and parents (if applicable)
- Student's alien registration number (only for eligible non-citizens)
- Birthdates and email addresses for student and parents
- 2009 income statements (W-2's, 1099's, etc.) for student and parents, or information to help estimate 2009 earnings
- Completed 2009 federal income tax return (IRS Form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ) for student and parents (if tax filers)
 - ~ If you do not have the 2009 tax return completed by the time you file your FAFSA, you may submit with estimates using your 2008 tax return and other income
 - ~ If you are not required to file a 2009 federal tax return, please bring any income records for 2009
- Information on any untaxed income (i.e. child support, payments to tax-deferred accounts, worker's compensation, disability, veteran's non-education benefits, etc.)
- Checking and savings account balances for the student and parents
- Other asset information, including the net worth of secondary properties and other investments
- A list of post-secondary schools the student is interested in attending
