- An ordinance introduced by Mayor Richard M. Daley authorizing the execution of an intergovernmental agreement with the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago regarding stormwater management.
- An ordinance introduced by Mayor Richard M. Daley authorizing 2009 funding and a project list pursuant to a previously executed settlement with People's Gas.
- An ordinance introduced by Mayor Richard M. Daley amending various provisions of the Municipal Code regarding air quality and pollution control.
- An ordinance introduced by Robert W. Fioretti Alderman, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ward, requiring businesses that sell fluorescent bulbs (CFL) provide recycling, free of charge, for used CFL bulbs.
- A resolution introduced by Margaret Laurino Alderman, 39<sup>th</sup> Ward, calling for the City Council to promote the expansion of the number of Farmers' Markets, Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) programs, community gardens, and other values which provide healthful plant based foods.
