Summary of Report

Police & Fire Committee Meeting – Tuesday, July 21, 2009

To the President and Members of City Council:

Your Police and Fire Committee held a meeting on **Tuesday, July 21, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in City Hall, Room 201-A**, having had under consideration the following matters:

- I. A communication introduced by **Mayor Richard M. Daley**, requesting the appointment of Gene Saffold to a term effective immediately and expiring July 1, 2010, as a member and chairman of the ***Chicago Emergency Telephone System Board***, to fill unexpired term of Bennett Johnson III, who resigned. **THE ORDINANCE WAS PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY THE COMMITTEE.**
- II. A communication introduced by **Mayor Richard M. Daley**, requesting the appointment of William Boyle to a term effective immediately and expiring July 1, 2013 as a member of the ***Chicago Emergency Telephone System Board***, to fill unexpired term of Kevin R. Sullivan, who resigned. **THE ORDINANCE WAS PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY THE COMMITTEE.**
- III. A communication introduced by **Mayor Richard M. Daley**, requesting the re-appointment of Michael Callahan to a term effective immediately and expiring July 1, 2014, as a member of the ***Chicago Emergency Telephone System Board***. **THE ORDINANCE WAS PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY THE COMMITTEE.**

- IV. An ordinance introduced by 11th Ward Alderman James A. Balcer. This ordinance amends **Section 10-40-260 of Municipal Code** related to the *Boat Registration & Safety Act*. **THE ORDINANCE WAS HELD IN COMMITTEE PENDING FURTHER REVIEW AND SUBJECT TO CALL OF THE CHAIRMAN.**
- V. An ordinance introduced by 7th Ward Alderman Sandi Jackson. This ordinance authorizes and directs the Superintendent of the Chicago Police Department (CPD) to temporarily deploy more patrol officers in areas of the South Shore community of Chicago, where there has been a significant increase in violent criminal activity. **THE ORDINANCE WAS HELD IN COMMITTEE PENDING FURTHER REVIEW AND SUBJECT TO CALL OF THE CHAIRMAN.**
