An ordinance to amend Section 4-156-330 of the Municipal Code of Chicago regarding location restrictions for VFW Hall or Masonic Hall. **(Alderman Freddrenna Lyle)**

An ordinance to amend Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago regarding the prohibition of licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor in portions of the 16th Ward. **(Alderman JoAnn Thompson)**

An ordinance to amend Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago deleting subsection 4-60-023 (27.410). **(Alderman Walter Burnett, Jr.)**

An ordinance to amend Chapter 4-4 of the Municipal Code of Chicago adding a new Section 4-4-025 regarding license denial for conviction of sex offenses against children. **(Alderman Ray Suarez and others)**

An ordinance to amend Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago deleting subsection 4-60-022 (39.84). **(Alderman Margaret Laurino)**

An exception to the Wrigley Field Adjacent Area Ordinance, the term "Game days" shall include any lawfully produced musical performance open to the general public at an open air stadium subject to the restrictions of Section 4-156-430 of the Municipal Code of Chicago. **(Alderman Thomas Tunney)**

An ordinance to amend Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago deleting subsection 4-60-022 (47.60). **(Alderman Gene Schulter)**

Thirty-five orders directed to the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Services, The Department of Revenue, the Department of Construction and Permits, the Department of Streets and Sanitation, and the Department of Transportation to waive fees for various special events. **(Aldermen Allen, O'Connor, Mary Ann Smith and Gene Schulter)**
