I, Jane M. Byrne, Mayor of the City of Chicago,
in the State of Illinois, hereby declare and order
as follows:

That the Memorial Day holiday provided in
Section G of the Resolution in relation to
employees benefits and compensation for
the year 1979 will be Monday, May 28, 1979.
Accordingly, this will be a holiday for all
salaried City employees and for prevailing
rate employees subject to the control of
the Mayor and the City Council, except for
those employees providing essential services.
Wednesday, May 30, 1979, will be a regular
working day for all City employees. This
Order supersedes all previous Orders or
directives.


EXECUTIVE ORDER

I, Jane M. Byrne, Mayor of the City of Chicago, in
the State of Illinois, hereby declare and order as follows:

That effective 5:00 P.M., November 8, 1982, the
Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation for the
City of Chicago is hereby ordered to revoke any
and all active permits issued to Peoples Gas Light
and Coke Company to make any openings in any public
way or public place for the purpose of terminating
gas service to consumers within the City of Chicago,
for non-payment of a bill or deposit.

This order is issued to preserve and protect the
public health and welfare.
