

Share the Road Day Resolution

**WHEREAS**, Each year City Clerk Miguel del Valle's office hosts an annual vehicle sticker art design contest inviting Chicago public and private high school students to participate by submitting artwork highlighting a specific theme; and

**WHEREAS**, As more Chicago residents travel by bicycle, the Thirteenth Annual Vehicle Sticker Art Design Contest theme "Share the Road" was selected to highlight the importance of roadway safety; and

**WHEREAS**, City Clerk Miguel del Valle partnered with the Chicago Department of Transportation to co-host the 2008 – 2009 vehicle sticker art design contest promoting the City of Chicago's efforts to make roads safe and friendly to all including bicyclists, pedestrians, and motorists; and

**WHEREAS**, Student participants were asked to submit artwork incorporating the theme Share the Road in their designs along with the image of a bicycle; and


**WHEREAS**, Last November, students from 60 high schools submitted over 400 designs promoting roadway safety for the chance to have their artwork displayed on the 2008 – 2009 vehicle sticker; and

**WHEREAS**, Patsy Diaz, a senior at Jones College Prep, was chosen by the public as the winning student artist and will have her Share the Road design displayed on approximately 1.3 million vehicles beginning in June 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, Education, awareness, and safety are essential to prevent roadway collisions; and

**WHEREAS**, To highlight the Share the Road message and publicly recognize the responsibility all roadway users have when traveling on City of Chicago streets; now, therefore,




