New Chicago City Clerk Satellite Office Hours

Chicago, Ill. (August 20, 2009) – Beginning Wednesday, Sept. 2, the two Chicago City Clerk satellite offices will have new office hours. The satellite offices will now be open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Offices will no longer be open later on Wednesday evenings.

City Clerk satellite offices are located at 5674 S. Archer Avenue on the Southwest Side and 5430 W. Gale St. on the Northwest Side of the city. The City Hall office hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday remain the same.

The Clerk's office made the difficult decision to make a minor reduction in satellite office service hours after analyzing constituent usage of the extended Wednesday office hours.
