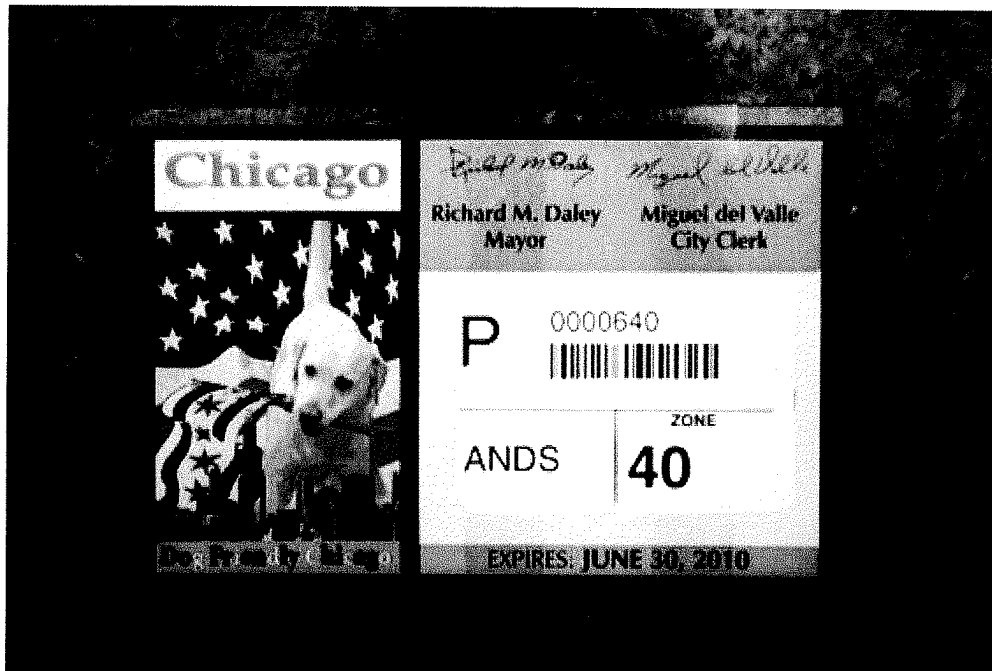

## New city stickers pack info on parking, plates

Chicago drivers will get a car sticker that combines their residential permit parking sticker with their regular city sticker in what officials hope will clear windshields, speed up the application process and save the city money.

Next week, more than 1.3 million vehicle notices will be sent to remind drivers they need to renew their city stickers, which expire June 30. Prices are \$75 for a car and \$120 for an SUV or truck.

City Clerk Miguel Del Valle said the new sticker makes it "easier for the

consumer" while also saving the city about \$140,000 by modernizing how the stickers are made and mailed out, and by cutting back on workers' overtime hours.

For the first time, license plate numbers will be included, along with other features to curb theft. Order stickers at [www.chicityclerk.com](http://www.chicityclerk.com).
