

Sticker deadline nears

City Clerk Miguel del Valle is providing additional neighborhood locations for citizens to get a city vehicle stickers. Specified locations will sell passenger, larger passenger, senior citizen, and truck (A) vehicle stickers.

Vehicle stickers and residential parking permits expire on June 30. The city provides a 15-day grace period for vehicle stickers before enforcement begins July 16, but there is no grace period for residential parking permits. Vehicle stickers are available at City Hall, City Clerk satellite offices, Department of Revenue Substations, currency exchanges, participating banks and retailers and on select days at aldermanic offices. Currency exchanges, banks, and retailers can charge a service fee of up to \$5.50 for selling consumers vehicle stickers. (City of Chicago Municipal Code 3-56-075(a)).

Stickers are available at City Clerk facilities at 121 N. LaSalle St. and 5430 W. Gale St., (the former Jefferson Park police station) in Chicago. Buy online at www.ChiCityClerk.com. Sticker renewal mailings list aldermanic office dates.
