**PROCRASTINATORS BEWARE:
Display 2008 – 2009 Vehicle Sticker by
JULY 15th Deadline or Face Penalty Fee**

City Clerk Miguel del Valle reminds residents that the 2008 – 2009 city vehicle sticker and residential parking permits must be displayed by July 15th. City Clerk del Valle provides a 15-day grace period from July 1st – July 15th for residents to purchase and display their city vehicle stickers and residential parking permits. Chicago residents purchasing the city vehicle sticker after the July 15th deadline face a possible \$120 failure to display citation and a \$40 penalty fee will be added to the purchase of a city vehicle sticker.

Several options are still available to residents in need of a 2008 – 2009 city vehicle sticker including:

- All Chicago Jewel-Osco locations
- All Chicago Dominick's locations
- Participating banks
- Currency Exchanges
- On select days at Aldermanic offices

Currency Exchanges, banks, and retailers can charge a service fee of up to \$5.50 for selling consumers vehicle stickers. (City of Chicago Municipal Code 3-56-075(a)) For a list of locations visit www.ChiCityClerk.com.
