## **Avoid the Lines and the Fines, Buy Your City Vehicle Sticker Today!**

*\$120 Ticket Looms for Procrastinators*

City Clerk Miguel del Valle reminds Chicago residents and business owners that the city vehicle sticker deadline is fast approaching. Vehicle owners' failure to purchase and display the 2008-2009 vehicle stickers before the June 30<sup>th</sup> deadline, with a grace period running through July 15<sup>th</sup>, are subject to a \$120 ticket. Failure to display a residential parking permit may result in a \$50 ticket. City Clerk del Valle expanded the number of locations for residents to purchase vehicle stickers this year.

"The most convenient way to buy your vehicle sticker and renew your residential parking permit is on our website. In addition, we have teamed up with Aldermen's offices, banks, retailers, currency exchanges, and the City of Chicago Department of Revenue to make getting them as easy as possible," said City Clerk Miguel del Valle.

Residents are encouraged to avoid the lines and the fines by purchasing their vehicle stickers and residential parking permit renewals online at [www.ChiCityClerk.com](http://www.ChiCityClerk.com).

In an effort to accommodate residents during the remaining sales weeks, City Clerk del Valle's office is offering residents the opportunity to buy vehicle stickers at many locations throughout the City of Chicago including all Office of the City Clerk locations, Chicago Jewel-Osco and Dominick's locations, most Currency Exchanges, Department of Revenue substations, participating banks, and on select days at Aldermanic offices. Currency Exchanges, banks, and retailers can charge a service fee of up to \$5.50 for selling consumers vehicle stickers.
