City Vehicle Stickers Now Available Online
Clerk del Valle urges residents to avoid lines and buy stickers online

Chicago, Ill. (May 20, 2009) - City Clerk Miguel del Valle announced today that vehicle stickers are now available to purchase online at www.ChiCityClerk.com. Purchasing vehicle stickers online saves time and is easy and convenient. Residential zone parking and residential daily guest passes also can be purchased online.

"This year we are hoping to double the number of vehicle stickers sold online," said Clerk del Valle. "Buying your vehicle sticker, residential parking and daily guest passes online is simply the easiest and fastest way to get your stickers."

This year's Dog Friendly Chicago-themed sticker features several new updates and security enhancements. Residents who live in residential parking zones will find their zone number now printed on their annual vehicle sticker, eliminating the need for a second sticker.

As an added security measure, license plate information is now included on the stickers. Residents must know their license plate number when purchasing their sticker. Additional security features include new barcode technology and reflective particles in the sticker.

Using new printing and mailing technology, people who purchase their vehicle sticker online will receive them faster than ever before. There is no additional charge to purchase your sticker online. Vehicle sticker and residential zone parking prices are unchanged from last year.

More than 1.2 million vehicle sticker renewal notices will be sent to residents at the end of May. A renewal form is not necessary to purchase a vehicle sticker online. Residents can purchase their sticker by mail once they receive their renewal form. **Walk-in vehicle sticker sales begin the first week of June** at City Hall, City Clerk Satellite Offices, Department of Revenue Substations, and several community vendor locations. As in prior years, residents can also purchase a vehicle sticker at their Alderman's office on select sale dates.
